
Since I am living a temporal, earthly life, am I starting to “groan” or long for a permanent and eternal home that I belong to?

How should I feel, think or conduct myself knowing that my eternal inheritance has already been prepared for me in Heaven?



Through this living hope, I shall live a life of gratitude and generosity remembering and sharing with those without this hope, especially to the sick and needy in pain and suffering.

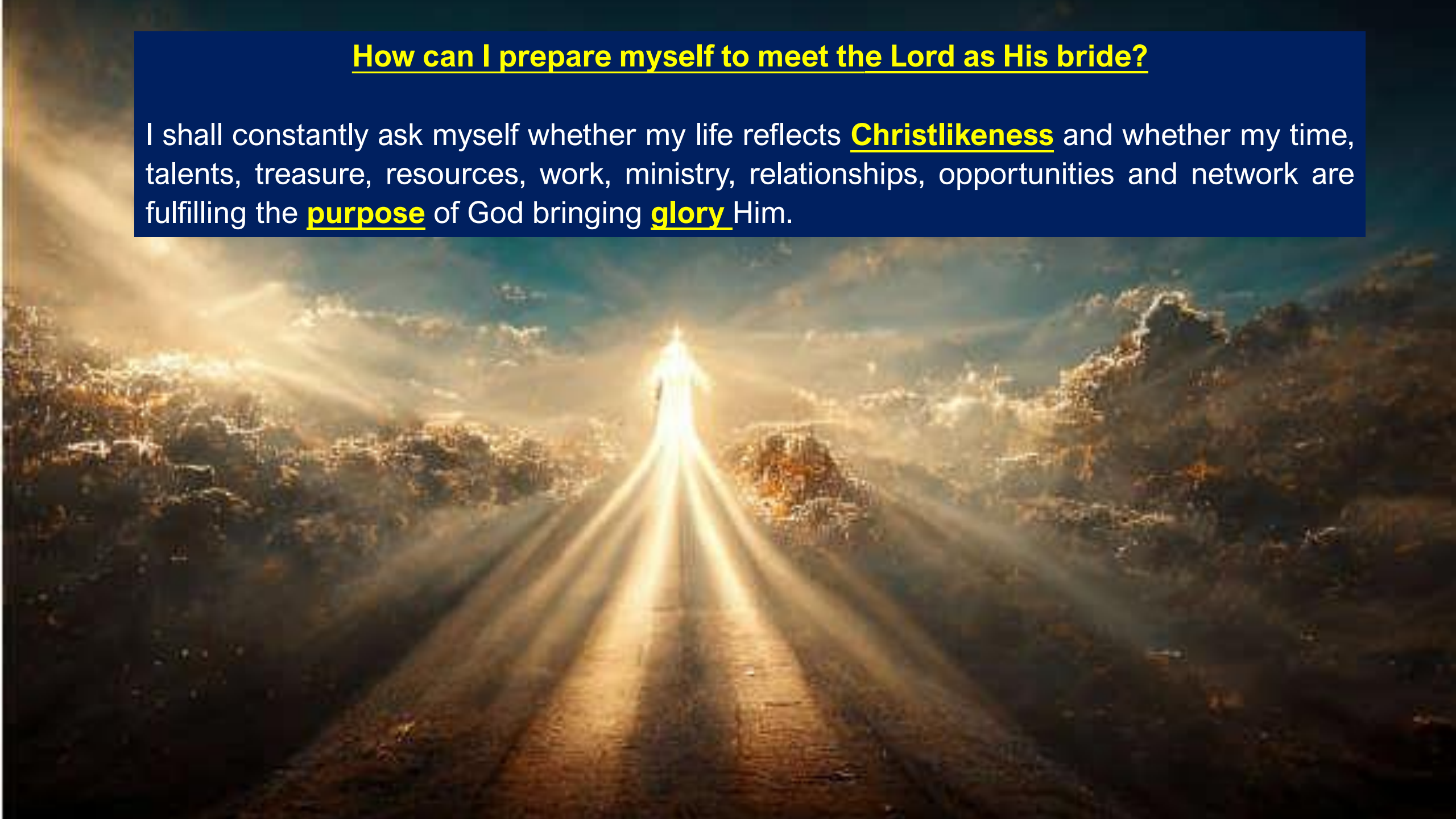


Revelation 21:1-2

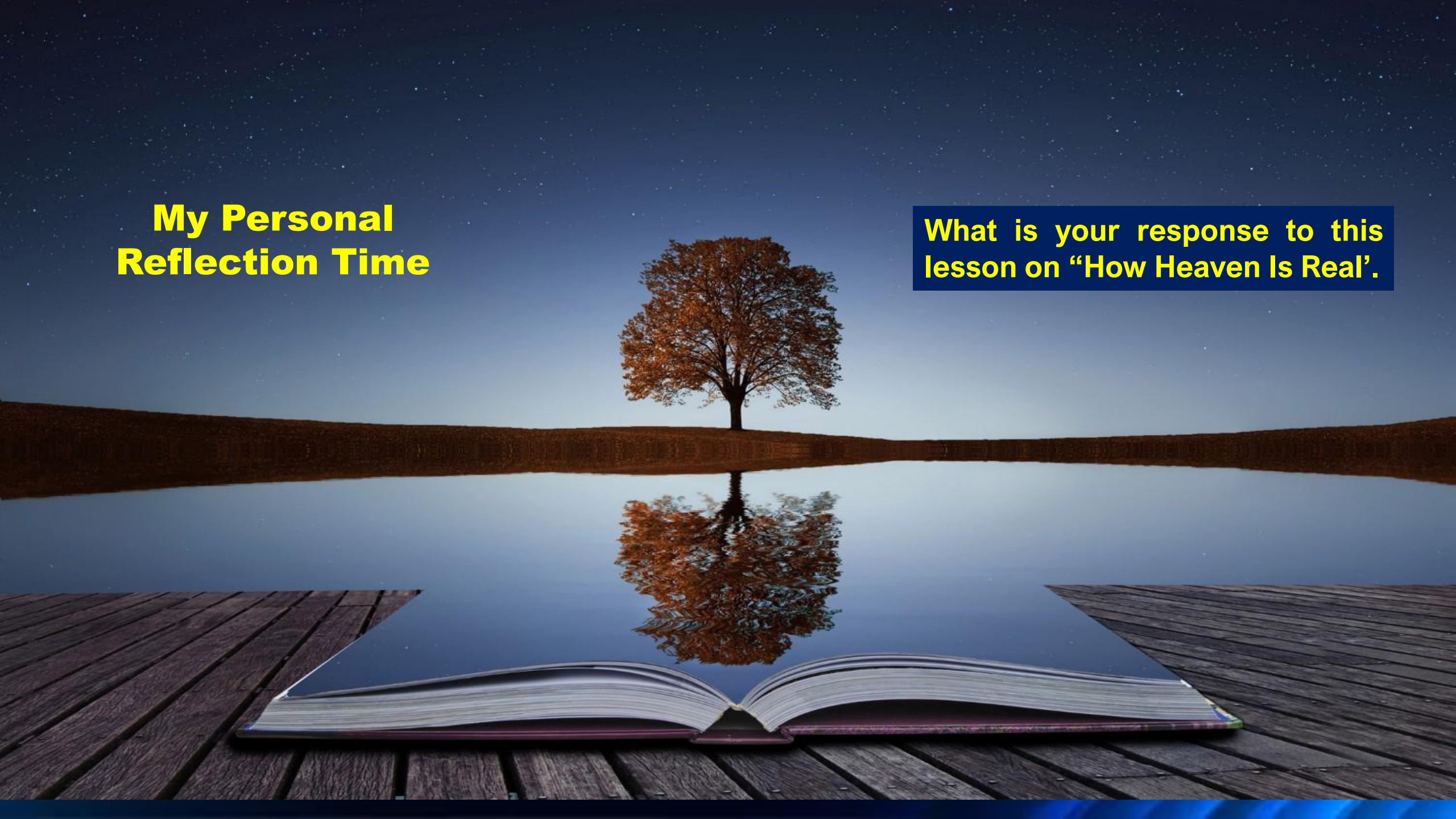
How can I prepare myself to meet the Lord as His bride?

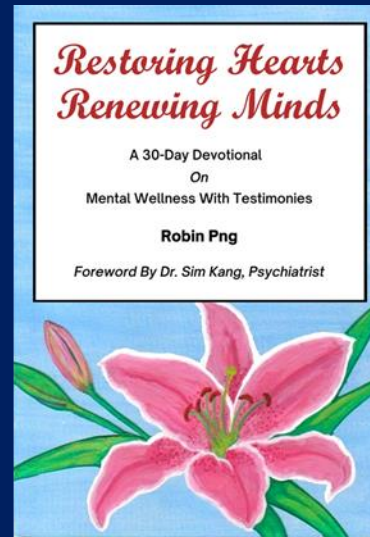
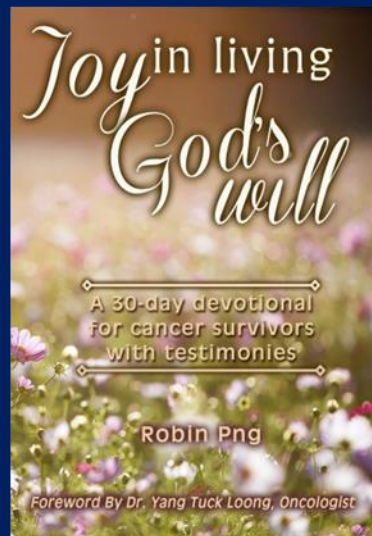
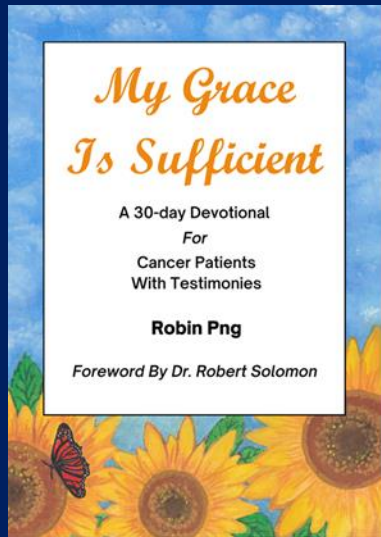
