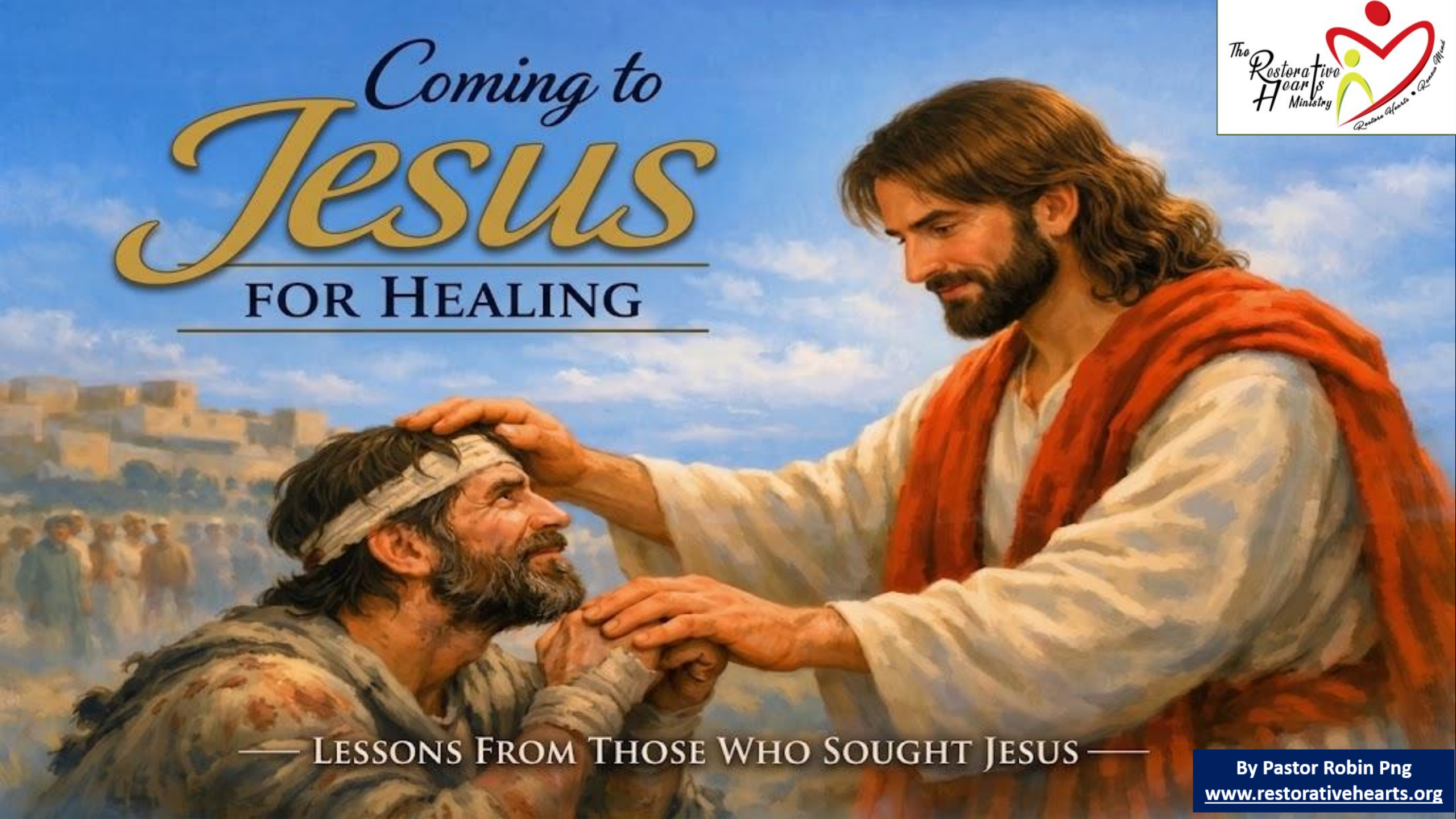


Coming to *Jesus* FOR HEALING

Introduction

The Gospels show individuals who personally came to Jesus with their needs, pain, and longing for healing—and each of these individuals was healed. Their stories reveal faith, humility, persistence, courage, dependence, obedience, and trust, encouraging us to bring our needs honestly before Jesus.





**Learning from individuals
who personally sought
healing from Jesus**

1. The leper — Matthew 8:1–3 ESV





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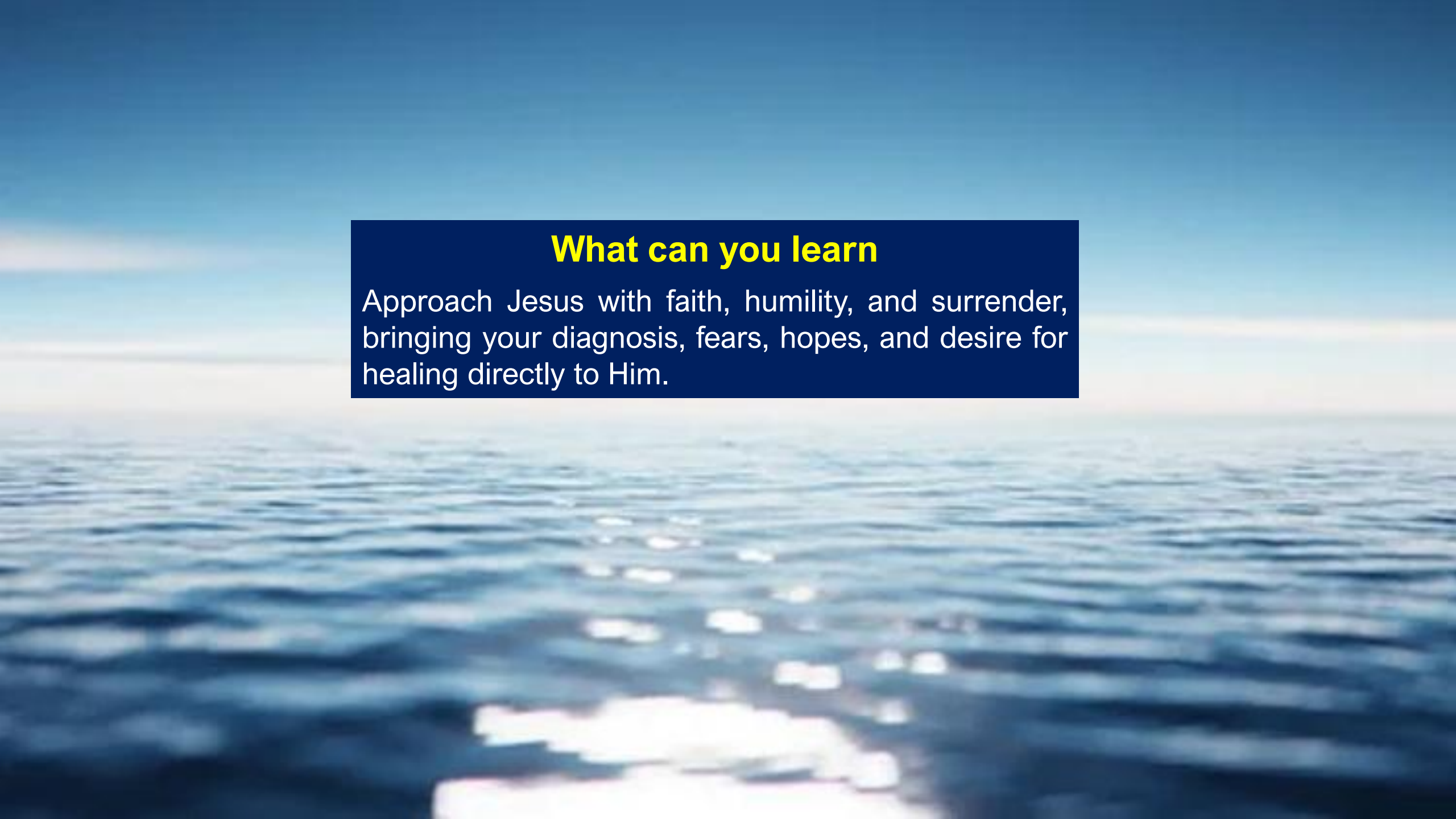
When he came down from the mountain, great crowds followed him.

And behold, a leper[came to him and knelt before him, saying, “Lord, if you will, you can make me clean.”

And Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, “I will; be clean.” And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.



He personally came to Jesus, knelt before Him and said, “Lord, if you will, you can make me clean.” Jesus touched him and healed him.



What can you learn

Approach Jesus with faith, humility, and surrender, bringing your diagnosis, fears, hopes, and desire for healing directly to Him.

2. The two blind men — Matthew 9:27–30 ESV

And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, “Have mercy on us, Son of David.”

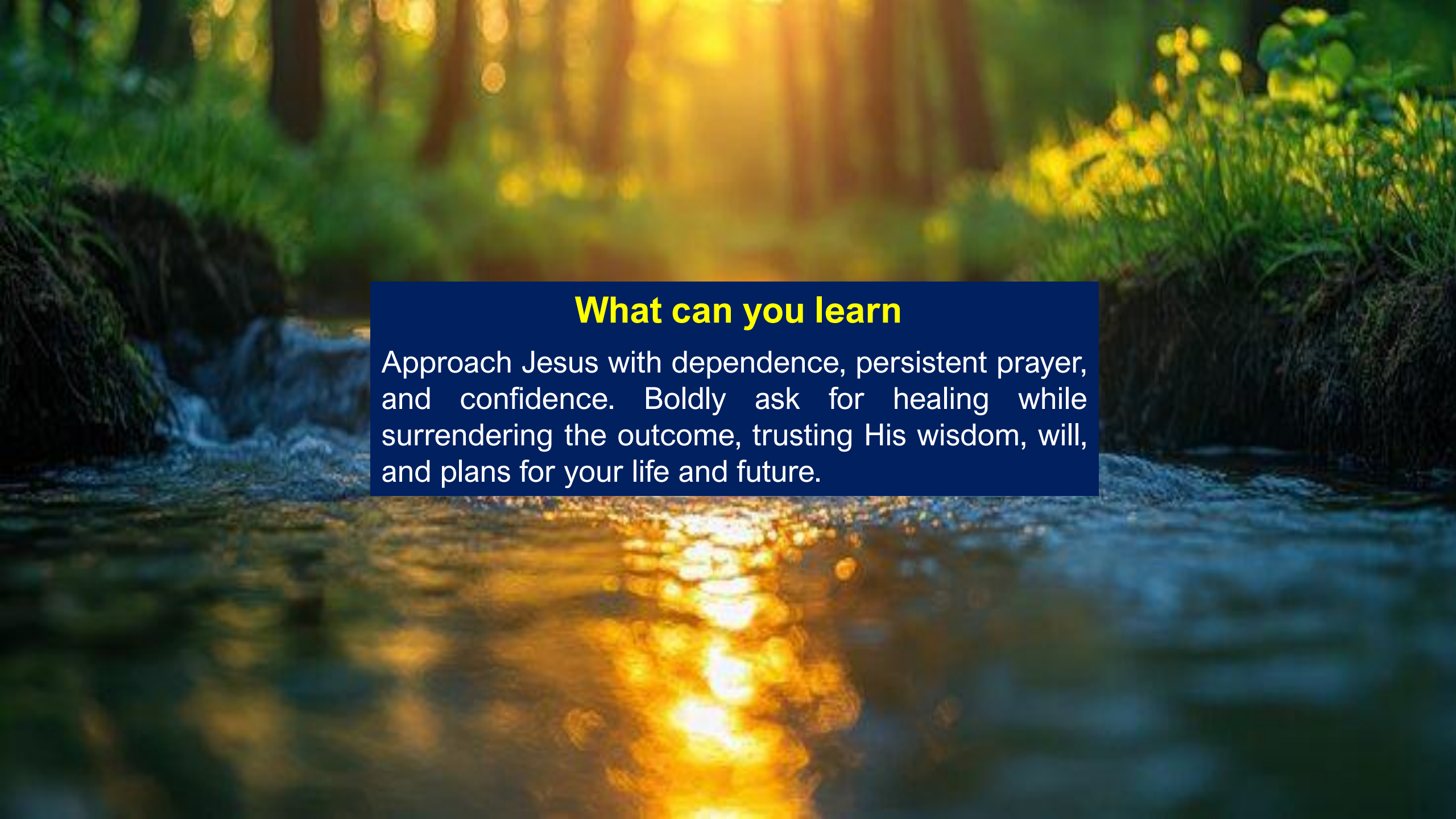
When he entered the house, the blind men came to him, and Jesus said to them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?”

They said to him, “Yes, Lord.” Then he touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith let it be done to you.”

And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, “See that no one knows about it.”



They followed Jesus, crying out for mercy. Jesus asked whether they believed He could heal them. They answered yes, and He touched their eyes and restored their sight.



What can you learn

Approach Jesus with dependence, persistent prayer, and confidence. Boldly ask for healing while surrendering the outcome, trusting His wisdom, will, and plans for your life and future.



3. The woman with twelve years of bleeding

1. The woman with twelve years of bleeding — Matthew 9:20–22

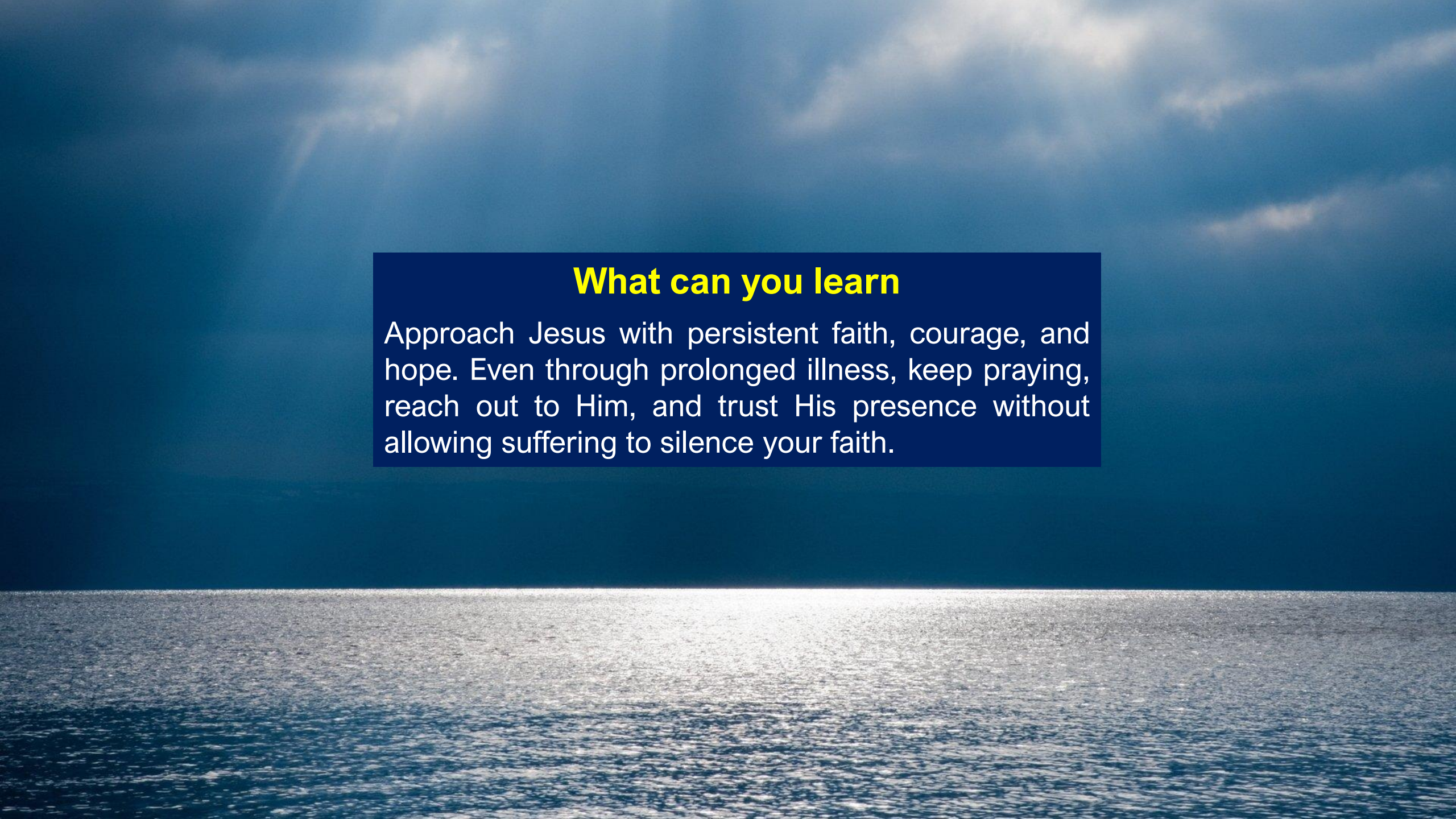
And behold, a woman who had suffered from a discharge of blood for twelve years came up behind him and touched the fringe of his garment, for she said to herself, “If I only touch his garment, I will be made well.” Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, “Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well.” And instantly^[a] the woman was made well.



She came behind Jesus and touched the fringe of His garment, believing she would be healed.

Jesus said, “Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well.”

What can you learn

Approach Jesus with persistent faith, courage, and hope. Even through prolonged illness, keep praying, reach out to Him, and trust His presence without allowing suffering to silence your faith.

4. The ten lepers



4. The ten lepers — Luke 17:12–19 ESV



And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance and lifted up their voices, saying, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.” When he saw them he said to them, “Go and show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went they were cleansed. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. Then Jesus answered, “Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?” And he said to him, “Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well.”

They personally cried out to Jesus, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.” As they went, they were cleansed. One returned to Jesus, glorifying God and giving thanks.



What can you learn

Recognize your need and depend on Jesus for mercy. Even when healing is uncertain, trust Christ as your hope, receiving His peace, strength, comfort, care, and daily provision.

5. Bartimaeus



5. Bartimaeus — Mark 10:46–52 ESV



And they came to Jericho. And as he was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a great crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the roadside.

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent.

But he cried out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” And Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.” And they called the blind man, saying to him, “Take heart. Get up; he is calling you.”

And throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. And Jesus said to him, “What do you want me to do for you?” And the blind man said to him, “Rabbi, let me recover my sight.”

And Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your faith has made you well.” And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way.



Bartimaeus personally cried out, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!”

When Jesus asked what he wanted, he said, “Rabbi, let me recover my sight.”

Jesus told him, “Your faith has made you well,” and he immediately regained his sight.



What can you learn

Approach Jesus with bold, persistent faith. Bring your specific needs honestly—healing, strength, peace, relief, or wisdom—and trust Him with the answer, without needing perfect words.

Persistence —

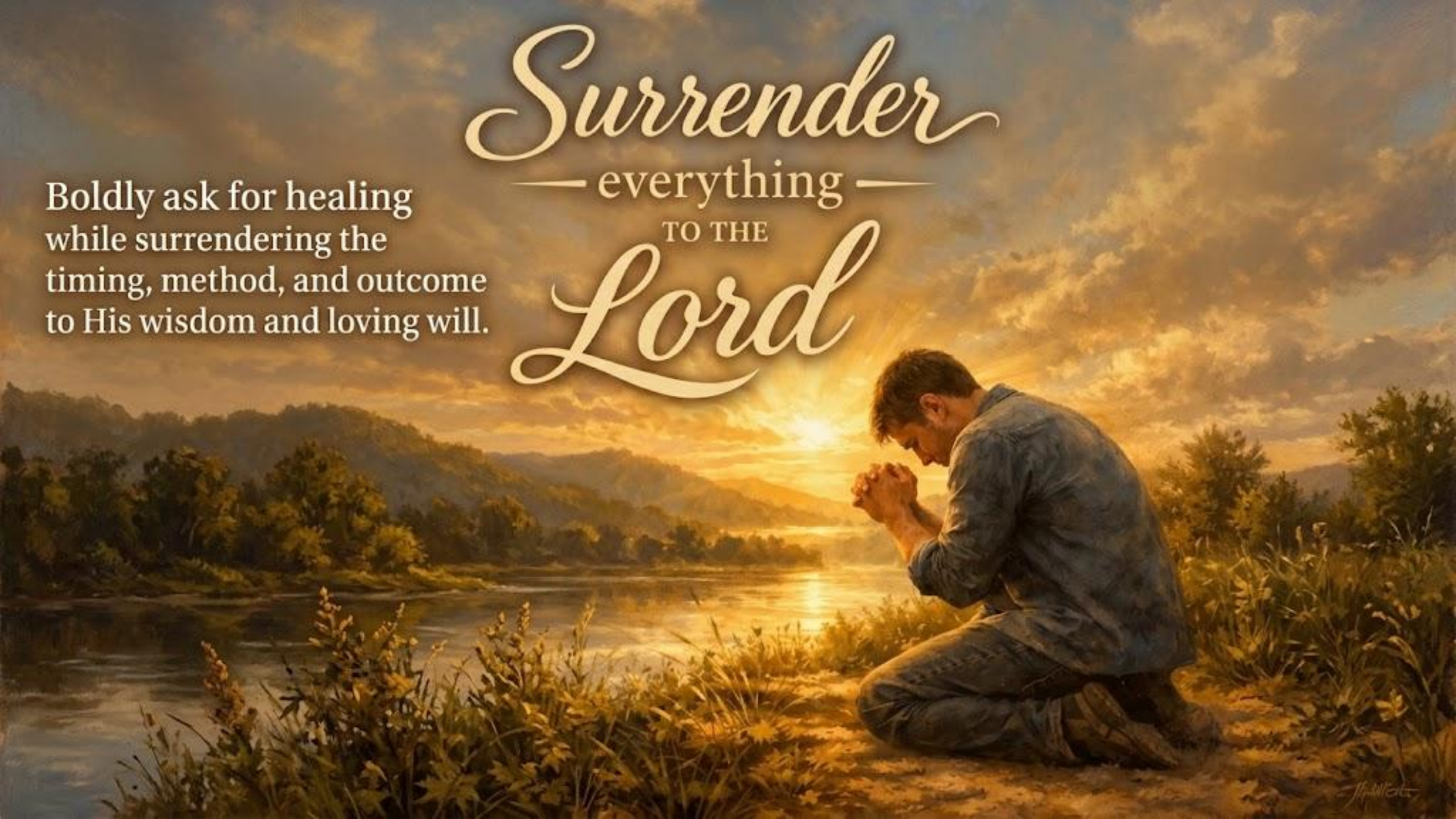
“I will keep seeking You.”

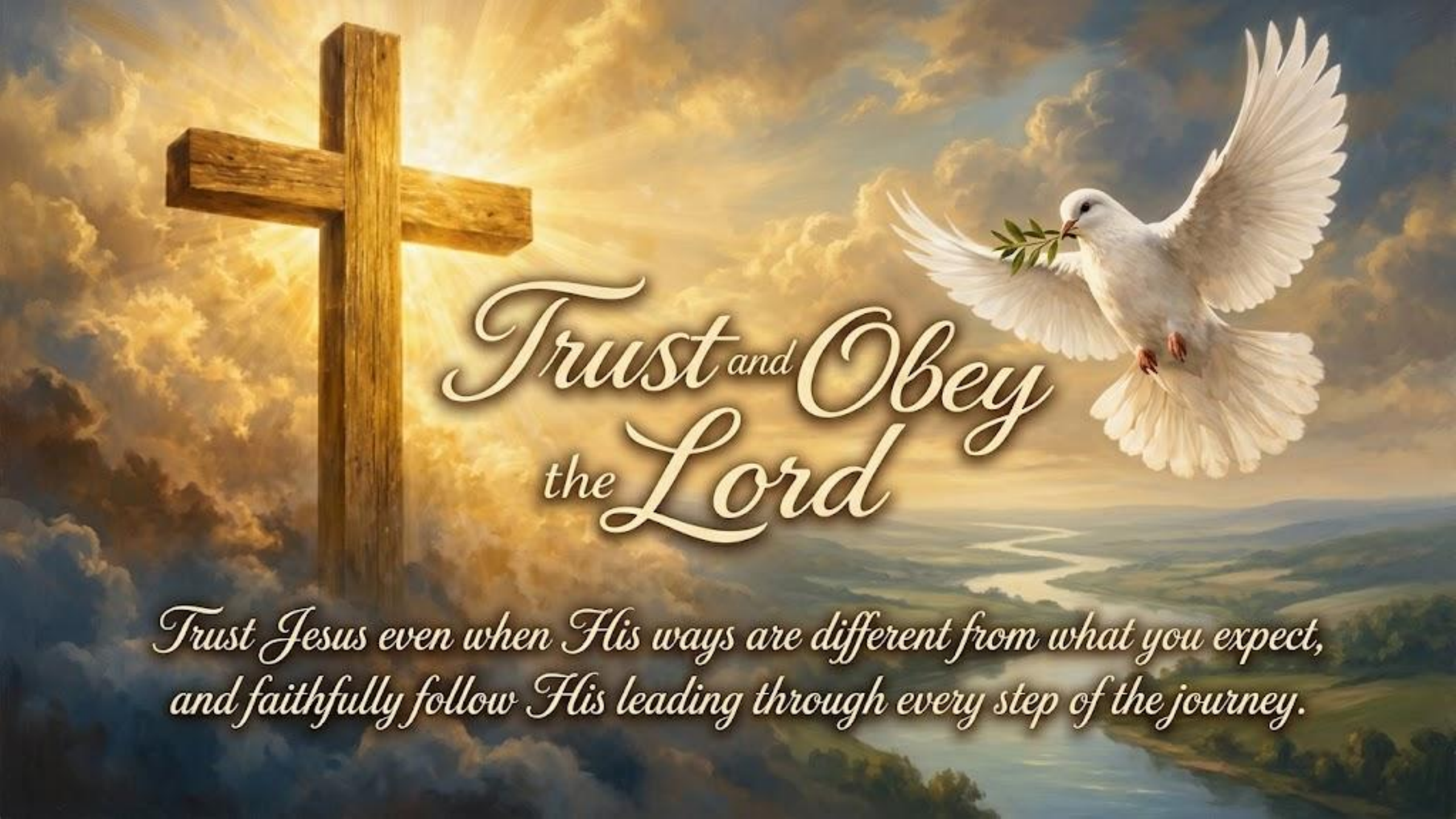
Continue praying and reaching out to Jesus,

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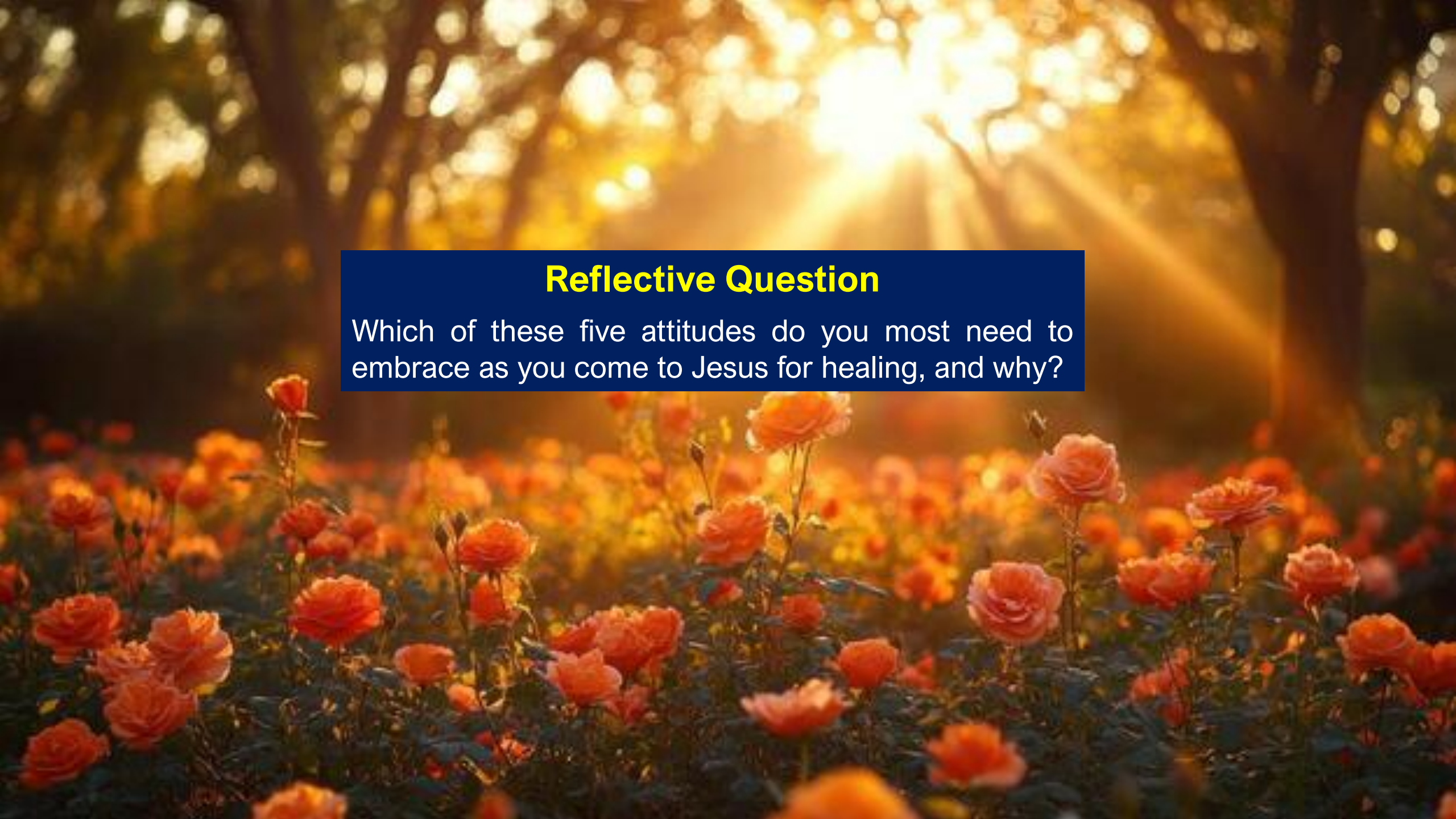

Prayer

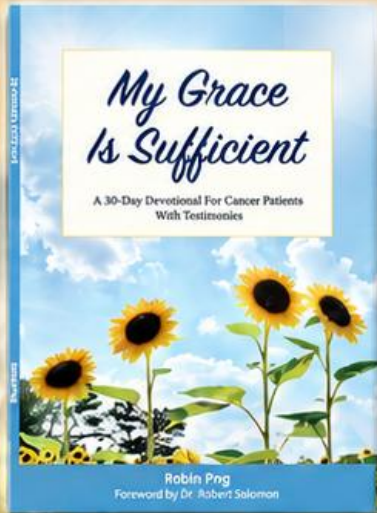
Dear Lord Jesus, I bring my needs, fears, hopes, and weaknesses before You.

Give me faith to ask, courage to persevere, humility to surrender, and obedience to follow.

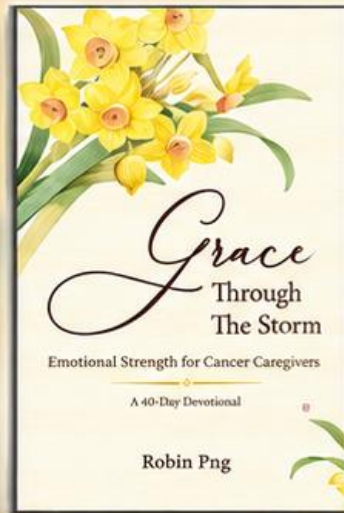
Help me trust Your wisdom and remain hopeful in every season. Amen.

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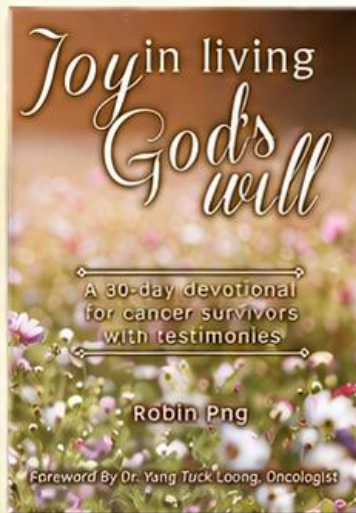
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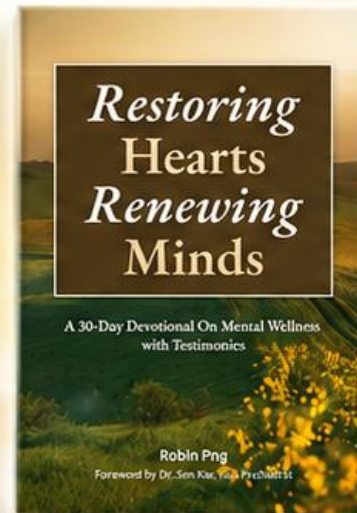

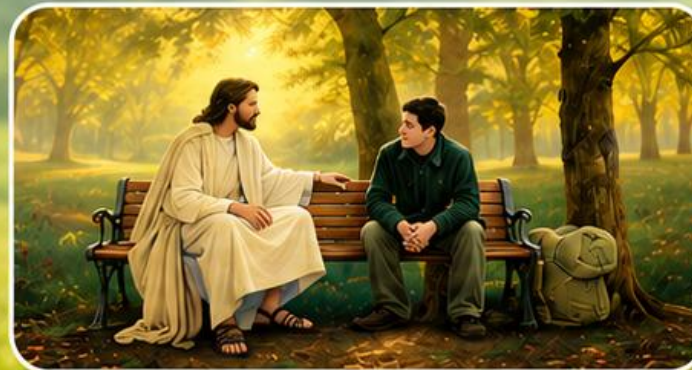
Our Vision
