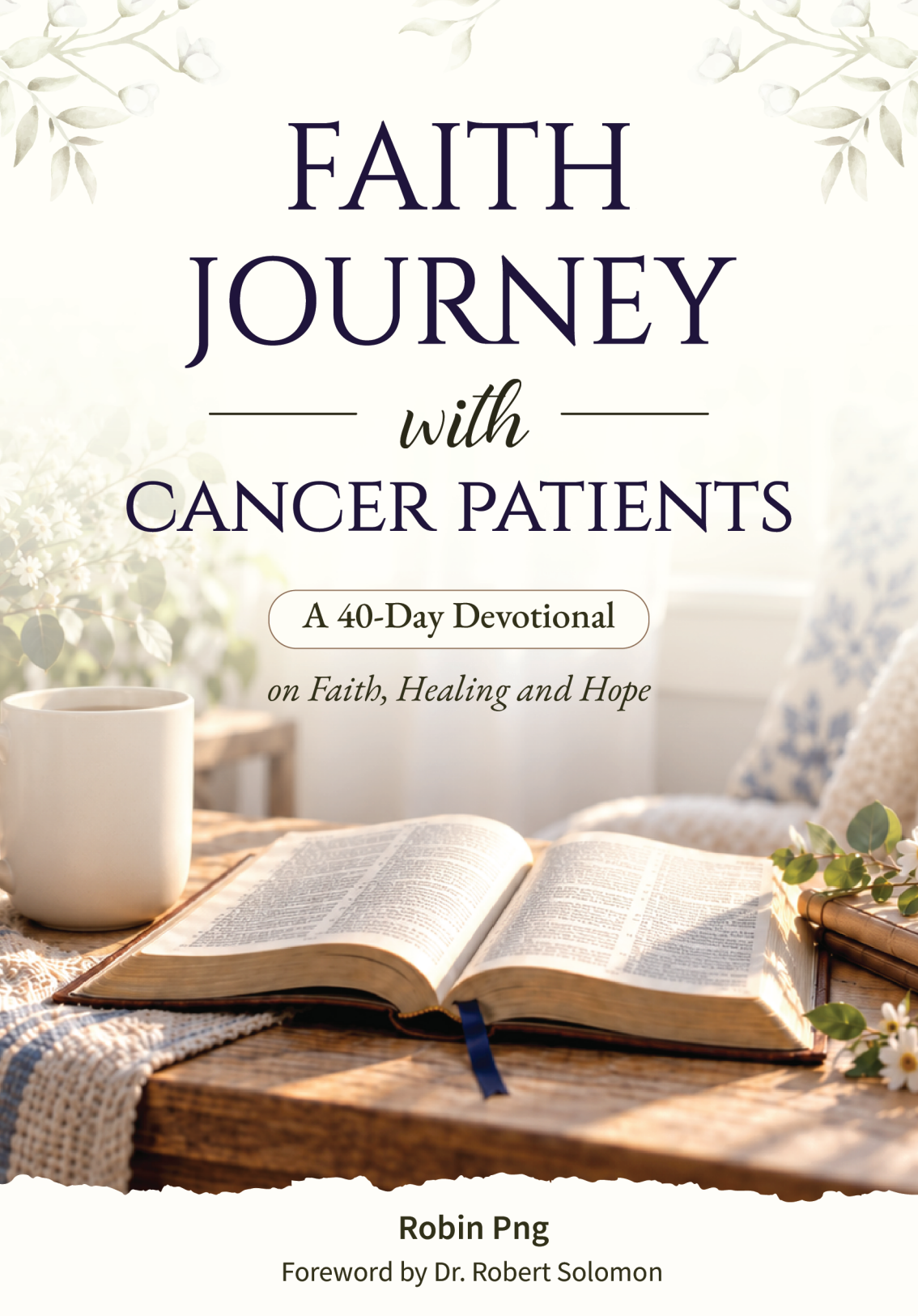

## **Day 1 - From Cancer To Christ-Centred Family**

When I first met Ophelia at our inaugural Cancer Wellness Talk on 18 January 2020, she was battling stage 4 breast cancer. She came with her husband, carrying many fears and uncertainties. After the talk, I prayed with her. Tears flowed down her cheeks, but I could sense God filling her heart with peace and hope.

Over the following months, Ophelia and her husband met with me for counselling and prayer. Together with their church family and many Christian friends, we trusted God for His strength and healing.

During her fifth chemotherapy session, a PET scan revealed no detectable cancer cells. We rejoiced and praised God for this wonderful news. Today, Ophelia remains in remission.

What touched me most was seeing God transform not only Ophelia but her whole family. Her husband accepted Christ after witnessing the love of God's people, and the family was later baptised together.

Today, Ophelia faithfully serves cancer patients and seniors, sharing the same hope and comfort that God so graciously gave her.

## **Spiritual Lesson**

God is able to bring lasting good out of painful circumstances. He not only restores lives but also transforms hearts, families, and relationships for His glory. Through His grace, He turns suffering into a testimony, enabling those He has helped to become a source of hope and encouragement to others.
